Prefestive day of the Procession of the Venerable Cross

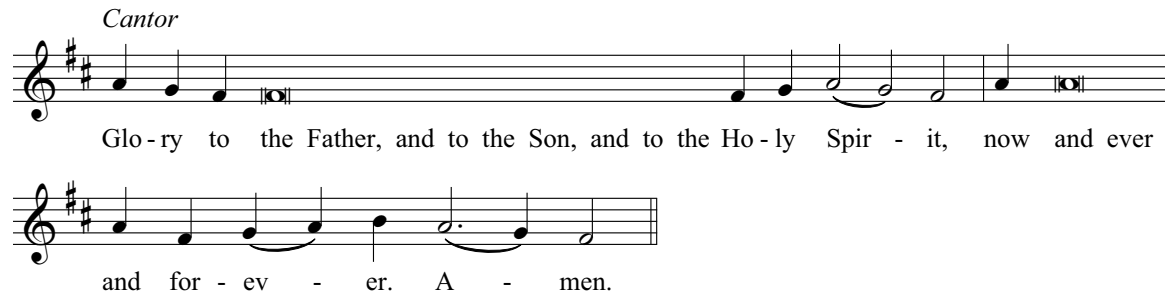
Troparion of the Resurrection - *Tone 6*

Troparion of the Cross - *Tone 1*

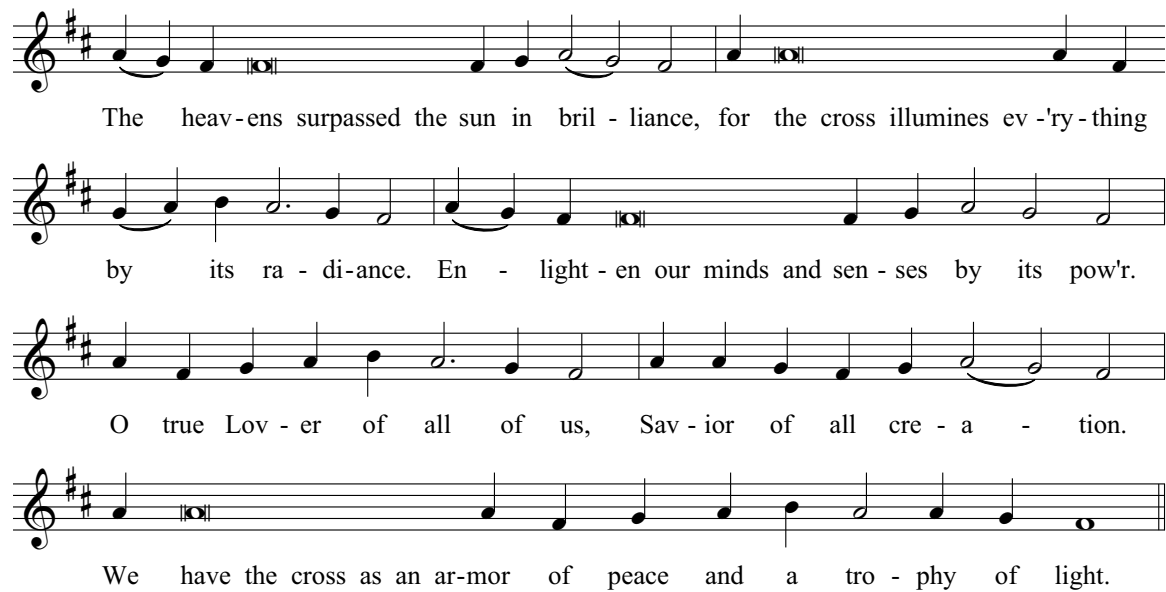
Save your peo - ple, O Lord, and bless your in - her - i - tance. Grant vic - to - ry

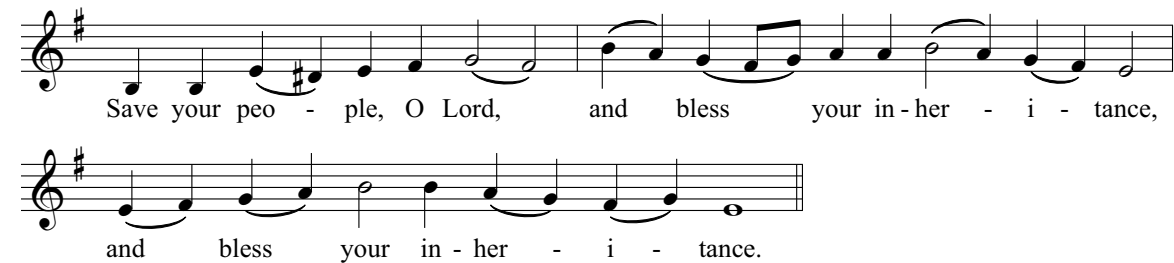

We have the cross as an ar-mor of peace and a tro - phy of light.

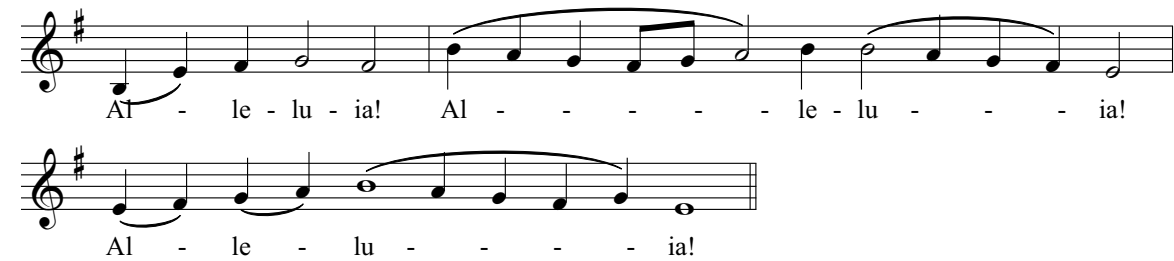
Prokeimenon of the Resurrection - Tone 6 (Psalm 27:9,1):
